Third Prize - \$100

## OFFICIAL RULES

### Theme:

Create awareness for organ, tissue and eye donation through poster art. Your design will help encourage others to help save and heal lives.

### Eligibility:

The middle school category is open to any student enrolled in grades 6-8.

The high school category is open to any student in grades 9 -12.

The computer-generated category is open to any student enrolled in grades 6-12. The contest is open to Michigan students only.

### Deadline:

Posters must be postmarked before midnight on April 1, 2019.

### Mailing:

Posters must be wrapped flat and mailed to:

### Poster Specifications:

1. Posters must be submitted on poster board.
2. The overall dimensions shall be approximately 15" x 20."
3. Posters created by more than one person will not be accepted.
4. All posters will become the property of the Michigan Donor Family Council.
5. Posters will be judged based on theme, spelling and illustrative quality.
6. No photographic reproduction of any individual will be accepted.
7. All illustrations and content submitted should be done in good taste.

### Identification:

The following information must be on the back of the poster on a 3" x 5" card.

1. Artist's name, age, grade and email.
2. Artist's home address and telephone number.
3. Name, address and telephone number of school.
4. Name of art instructor or classroom teacher, if any.
5. The category you are submitting.

### Notification & Display:

All winners will be notified by May 1, 2019.

Posters will be displayed on the Michigan Donor Family Council's social media, website and it's partners in the transplant community.
